


INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS **PART#4446(B-C-PS)**

- 1. Carrefully read and understand instructions before start installation. If You can not find all the listed parts, please stop installation and call to your distributor to get the missing pieces.
- 2. Locate at front underneath of vehicle the bolt and retainer shown in image 2 (shown driver's side). Remove existing bolt and plastic retainer, identify the larger hole and expose the smallest hole behind the plastic cover.
- 3. To install front bracket, introduce into larger hole (2) nut bracket, one of them should reach the smallest hole, the nuts must coincide with the smallest and larger holes, secure front bracket using (2) 3/8x1 1/4" hex bolt (2) 3/8" flat washer (2) 3/8" lock washer. Image 1 & 3
- 4. Underneath front/rear door there are existing holes cover with plastic grommets, remove the nearest groomet to the front mudguard, then introduce (1) small "T" bracket, place auxiliary bracket and secure using (1) 1/4" hex nut (1) 1/4" flat and lock washers. Secure the other end to the auxiliary bracket to the front/rear bracket using (1) 1/4x1" hex bolt (1) 1/4" flat and lock washers, (1) 1/4" hex nut. Image. 3

5. To install rear bracket, locate existing oval hole then (1) 3/8" hex nut (1) 3/8" flat and lock washer. Image 4.
